Any Other Business.

As the Chairman had not been contacted by the Highways Engineer to discuss a number of road surface issues which were causing concern, the Clerk said that she would make a further request for him to get in touch and arrange a meeting with the Chairman without further delay.

The Clerk advised that the village Notice Board needed replacing as the door did not fit due to, the hinges being rusty and falling to pieces allowing the rain to get in and the notice board itself was pulling away from the wooden posts to which it is fixed. Temporary repairs had been carried out but they would not last for long. It was agreed that enquiries be made as to the cost of a new notice board ready for discussion at the February meeting.

The Chairman agreed that the Parish Council would pay for the village Christmas Tree again this year.
