Minutes and Matters Arising

Minutes of the meeting held on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> February 2016 were approved as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

Wighton Cemetery Car Park. Tony Keeble and Andrew Green have now completed the work required to the Cemetery fencing and entrance to the car park. New gates have been made to the main cemetery entrance and a small gateway from the car park in to the cemetery

Carpenters Arms. On enquiring, the Chairman was advised that clarification was required on a matter relating to the erection of the detached dwelling in conjunction with the work to be carried out at the Carpenters Arms before planning consent could be given.

Street Lighting

The Clerk reported that the last of the 14 street lights have now been changed from SOX Sodium lamps to LED's, at a total cost of £5880.00. We were able to do this with a grant of £3250.00 from the Sheringham Shoal Community Fund, sponsorship of 2 lamps by local businesses and the balance being paid by the Parish Council. As the LED's are guaranteed for 10 years this will reduce our maintenance costs and with a lower electricity consumption, our electricity costs.
