

Wighton "New" Cemetery opened in November 1938 and is maintained by Wighton Parish Council. The cost of maintenance and repairs is taken from the annual Precept the Parish Council received from North Norfolk District Council and Cemetery Fees, which are shown below.

CEMETERY FEES

Part 1 - Internments

1. For internment in a grave of which no exclusive right of nuriel has been granted:
 - a) Of the body of a child not exceeding 12 years old No charge
 - b) Of the body of a person exceeding 12 years old £135,00
 - c) Cremated remains £60.00
2. For internment in a grave in respect of which the exclusive right of burial has been granted:

The fees are the same as internment in a grave with no exclusive right of burial.

Part 2 - Exclusive rights of burial in an Earthen Grave

1. For the exclusive right in perpetuity in an earthen grave
 - a) 7 feet by 3 feet £150.00
 - b) Cremated remains £ 60.00

Part 3 - Monuments, Gravestones and Inscriptions

1. For the right to erect and place a flat stone occupying a superficial area
 - a) Not exceeding 18 inches by 18 inches £60.00
2. For the right to erect and place a headstone
 - a) Not exceeding 4 feet in height £90.00
3. For the right to erecft and place a tablet £78.00
4. For the right to erect and place a gravestone in the form of a vase
 - a) Not exceeding 18 inches in height £48.00
 - b) Exceeding 18 inches in height £50.00
5. For the nright to place any inscription after the first £52.00

Part 4 = Searches of Registers and Copies taken therefrom - Price on application
